④ Applicants who have received up to secondary education in Japan cannot apply for the master's program of the Graduate school of Health and Sport Sciences.

⑤ Applicants who have graduated from a university in Japan cannot apply for the doctoral program of the Graduate school of Health and Sport Sciences.

  - ③ Enrollment fee is only required at the first year of the program.
  - ④ Tuition fee, educational supplement fee, and experiment and practical training fee are invoiced in twice in Spring semester and Fall semester.  
(Spring semester fee at the first year are included in total enrollment fee)
  - ⑤ 30% reduction in tuition fee is applied for all international students at the first two years of Master's Program and the first three years of Doctoral Program.
  - ⑥ By cancelling enrollment, fees excluding enrollment fee will be refunded.
